Kineton needs NHW coordinators

Kineton is rated as a low crime area and our intention is to keep it that way.

An essential element in the fight against crime is the Watch Relay messaging system for Warwickshire; this is centralised at Police HQ Leek Wootton and receives input from various sources.

The information is then verified before it is logged onto their computer and automatically distributed by 'phone, email and fax to almost 1400 Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) schemes and to an even greater number of coordinators who have volunteered to receive them; and who then distribute them, by hand if necessary, to the 15 or 20 houses designated to them.

Kineton needs NHW coordinators in the following areas:-

- *Banbury Street and Banbury Rd., including Walton Cottages and Walton Fields. We have one volunteer to cover 71 dwellings and need to split this between at least three more helpers.*
- *Dene Close, 16(dwellings),*
- *Hanbury Close, 11;*
- *Segrave Close, 13;*
- *King Johns Road, 32;*
- *Chadshunt Road, 2;*
- *Mill Crescent, 12;*
- *St. Peters Road, 127;*
- *St. Peters Court, 12.*
