



# Kineton Neighbourhood Watch

## Did you know....

That some insurers of house and contents will give a discount on premiums to members of an active Neighbourhood Watch scheme (NHW), and Kineton qualifies. A further discount if you have an intruder alarm that is installed by a nationally recognised supplier; so, check with your insurer first.

Also, an active scheme reduces the probability of burglary by a factor of ten; by active we mean that it has to be obviously so by street signs and NHW window logo's as well as by reputation.

### **Smartwater.**

I have a supply of NHW material and of 'Smartwater'; one small phial of this liquid (it resembles clear nail varnish), complete with instructions and discreet window logo's that declare its presence in a property, is enough to mark about 60 items. It is available from me at a subsidised price of £11.

Each phial has its own forensic signature. When applied in the recommended way it is difficult to remove, and to see, except by ultra violet light. The owner of that signature is registered with a central data base and makes stealing your valuables a risky business.
