117/05 APOLOGIES

Apologies for inability to attend were received from Cllrs Haywood ,Melville and DCllr Higgs.

118/05 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Councillor Mrs Knapton declared an interest in planning application 06/00636 as a neighbour and took no part in the discussion or voting thereon.

119/05 MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 1st March 2006 had been circulated. Their adoption was proposed by Councillor Mrs Knapton and seconded by Councillor Tuffen.

- a. **Old Library Iron Railings** – Cllr Melville reported by message that no further progress has been made and a letter should be sent to the owner requesting information on completion.
- b. **Banbury Road Traffic Management** – The Chairman reported on the recent County Council Cabinet meeting during which the issue of the Banbury Road has been deferred until new legislation is considered this year. County Councillor Booth also commented on this issue. It is likely that this will mean the project will slip at least two years !

The Clerk confirmed that the WCC Advisory Lorry Route map had been reissued.
