**88/05 APOLOGIES**

Apologies for inability to attend were received from DCllr Higgs.

**89/05 MINUTES**

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2005 had been circulated. Their adoption was proposed by Councillor Haywood and seconded by Councillor Tuffen.

**90/05 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

- a. **St Peters Road, HGVs** – The Clerk reported that he had now received a reply from WCC about a suitable site for the four Unsuitable for HGV signs particularly in relation to Mill Lane siting. Two of the signs will have to be amended from the standard due to space shortage at Mill Lane and erected on two poles each adjacent to the footpath. The total cost is £1200.

**RESOLVED: That no further action be taken on this matter at present.**

- b. **SWHA Refuse** – DCllr Higgs reported that matters were being progressed with the Electricity Supply Company to extend the fencing at the sub station. Refuse is still being left adjacent to the sub station. The letters have not been sent to the residents.
- c. **Old Library Iron Railings** – Cllr Melville reported that progress should be made shortly.
- d. **Rose Cottage Replacement Tree** – The Clerk reported that he had made contact with the site developer and the tree planted to replace the protected tree removed without permission is flourishing at the rear of the property. Further substantial trees will be planted to the front of the site shortly.

**92/05 TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT - BANBURY ROAD - RESIDENTS MEETING**
