### 24/06 MINUTES

### 27/06 RURAL HOUSING SURVEY

### 28/06 COVENTRY AIRPORT FLIGHT PATHS

The Clerk reported that he had sent the Parish Council objections to the proposed flight paths over the centre of Kineton village.

### 29/06 STOPPING UP HIGHWAY IN KINETON

The Clerk submitted a letter from WCC indicating their intention to apply for a stopping up order for a short section of Banbury Road adjacent to the recent development as searches have shown that some of the land is still incorrectly classed as highway. This action is required to regularise the status of the land.

**RESOLVED: That no objections be raised to this action.**

### 30/06 KINETON HANGING BASKET COMPETITION

The Clerk reported on the arrangements for the Kineton Hanging Basket Competition and judging will take place on 7<sup>th</sup> July. All hanging baskets seen from the public highway in Kineton and Little Kineton will be judged. The awards will be presented at the Parish Council meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> September.

**RESOLVED: That an initial sum of £ 150 be allocated to the competition for awards and expenses.**
