14/06 APOLOGIES

15/06 MINUTES

18/06 RURAL HOUSING SURVEY

Charles Barlow and Phil Ward attended from WRCC to explain about the principles behind a Housing Needs Survey for Kineton. There was discussion about whether a survey was justified and the matter was deferred to the next meeting. The Chairman thanked Charles Barlow for his presentation.

19/06 COVENTRY AIRPORT FLIGHT PATHS

Councillor Melville on behalf of District Councillor Higgs submitted a plan that shows that revised and new flight paths to Coventry Airport will pass immediately over Kineton village.

RESOLVED: That the Clerk writes to the Company representing Coventry Airport objecting to proposed revision of flight paths because of possible detrimental effect on Kineton.

20/06 HIGHWAY WORKS IN KINETON

The Clerk has circulated a copy of the highways works programme for certain roads in Kineton during June 2006.

21/06 RURAL CINEMA

The Clerk submitted a letter from Whatcote Village Hall giving information about Rural Cinema operating in Cotswold District. It was agreed that the information should be passed on to Kineton Village Hall Association.
