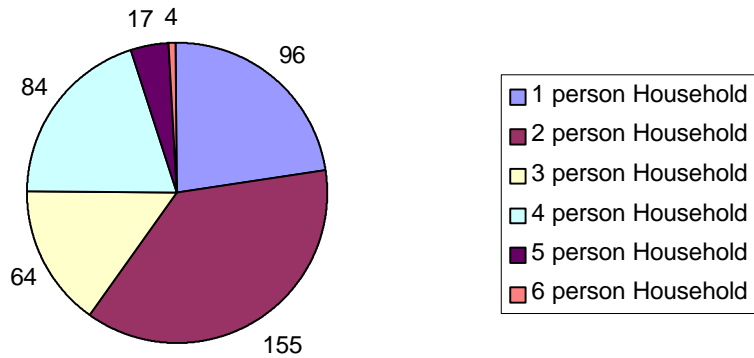


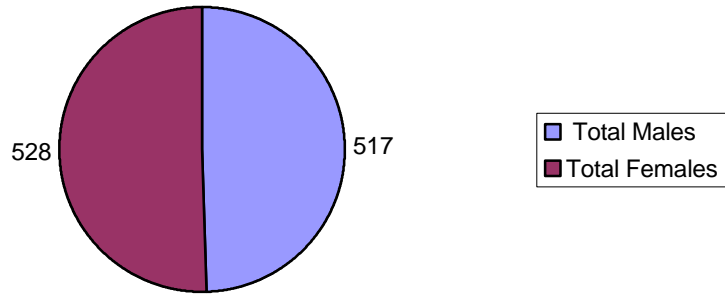

Total Households surveyed = 420

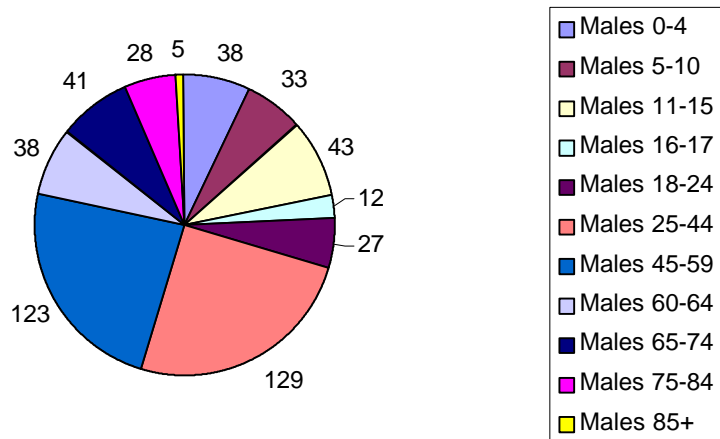
Genders in Households in Survey



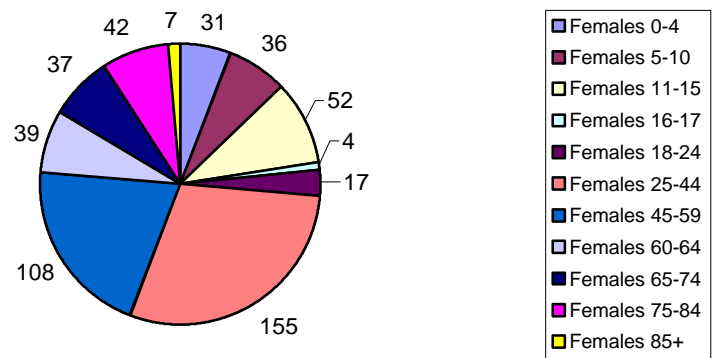

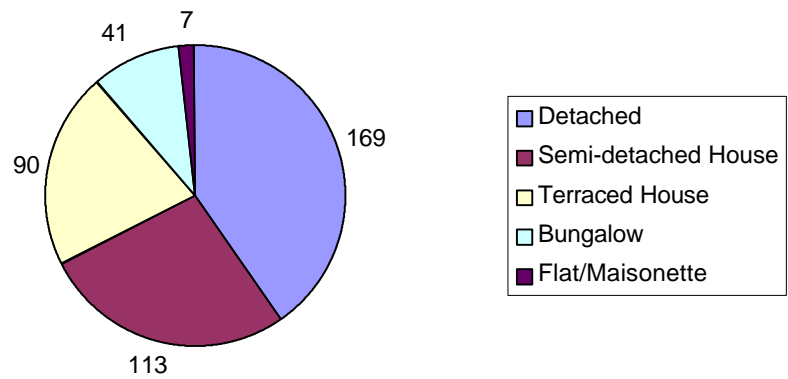
Ages of Males in Households

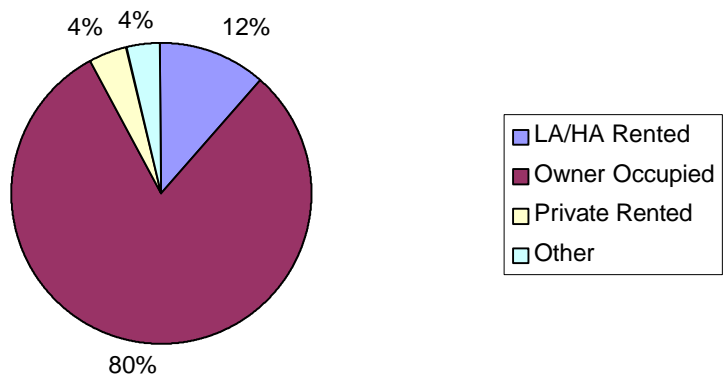


Ages of Females in Households



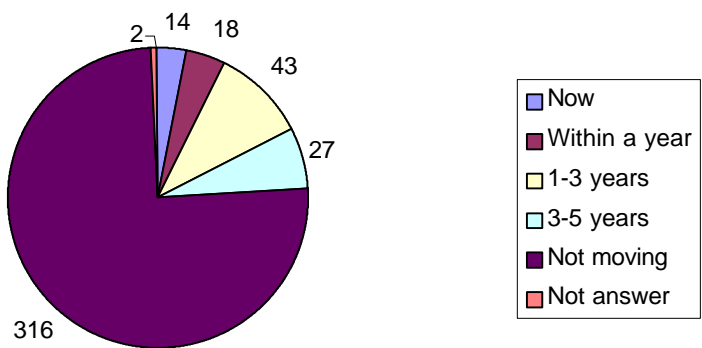
Types of Properties in Survey



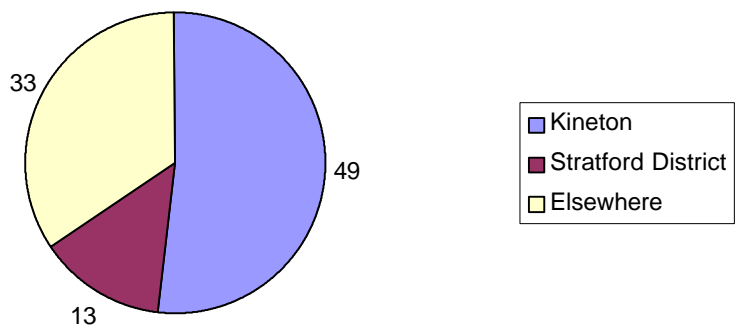

Do you or a member of your family need to move?

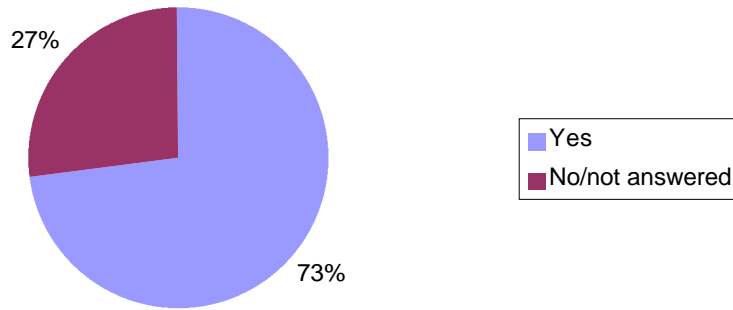

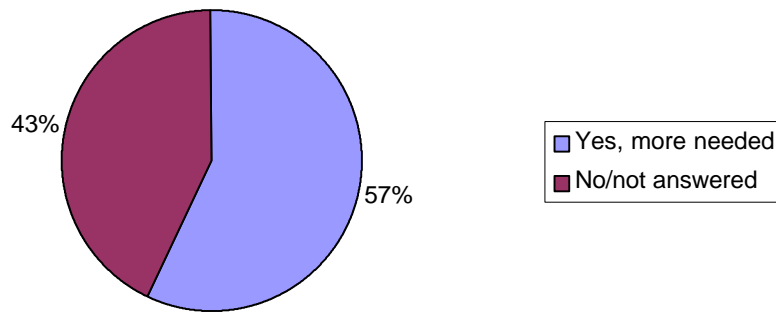

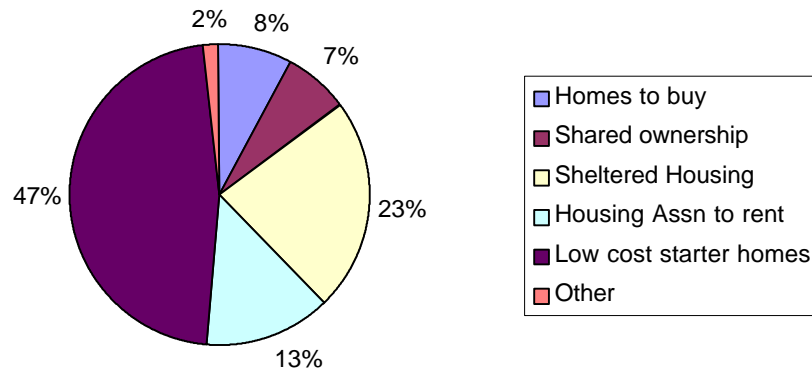
Is there enough Housing in Kineton for Your needs?



Is more Housing Needed for Local People?

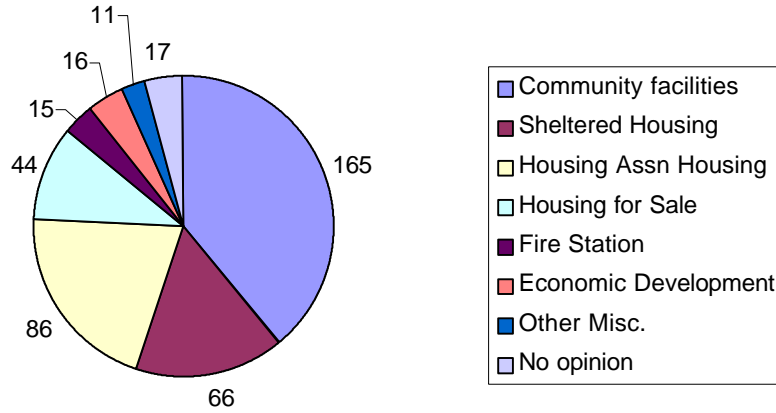


Type of Housing to be provided for local people?

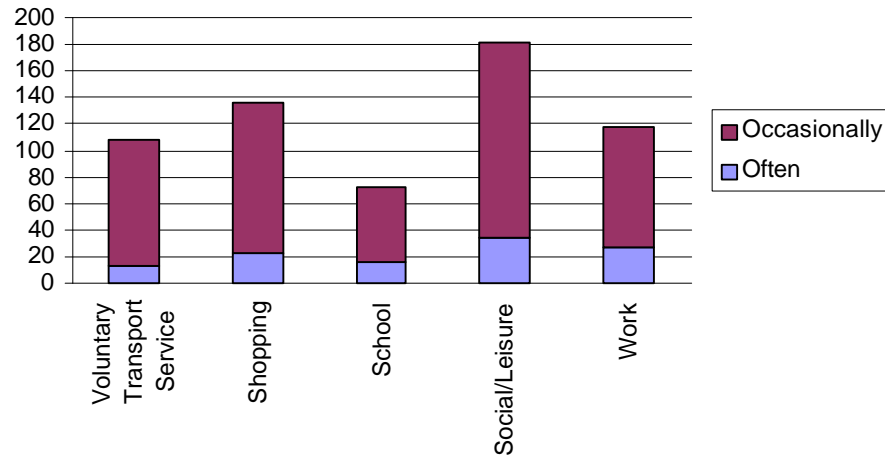

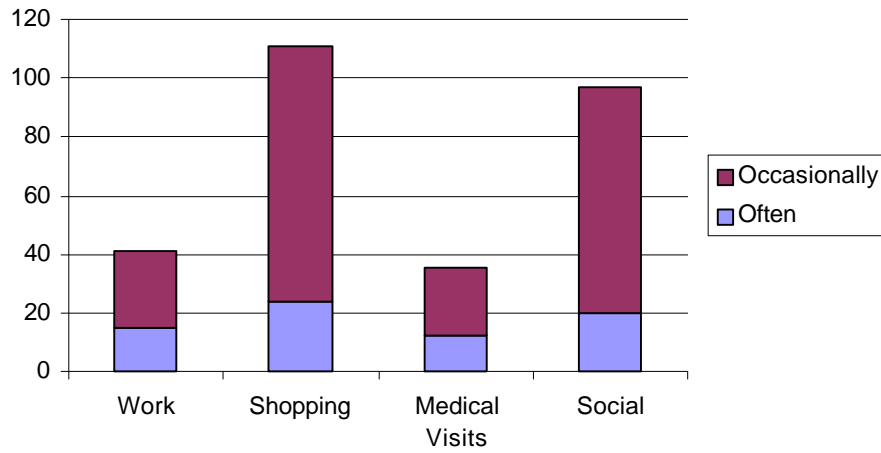

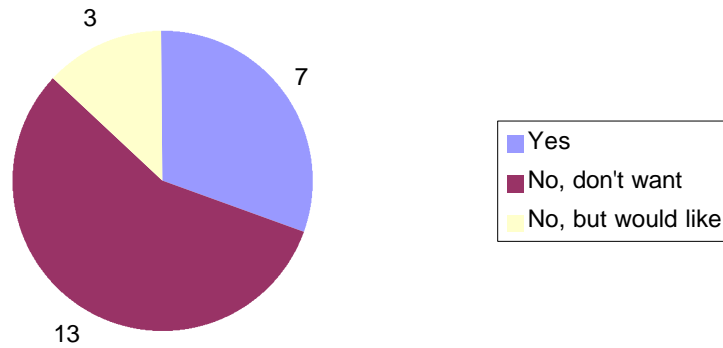

Are the services adequate for your needs?

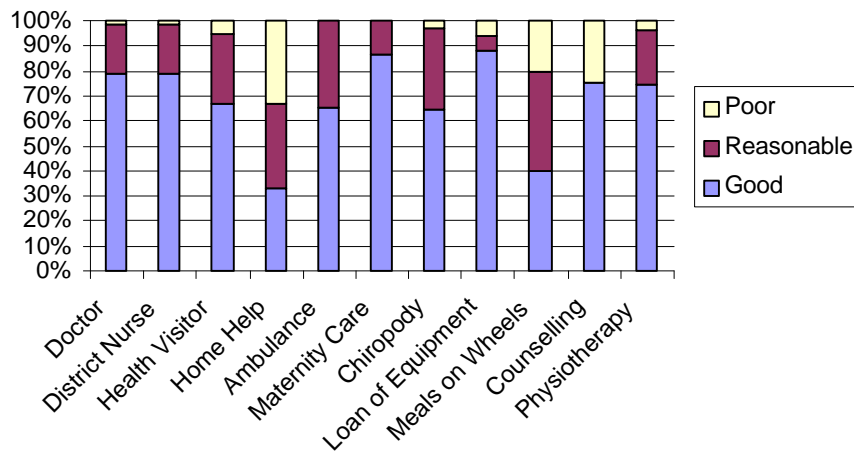

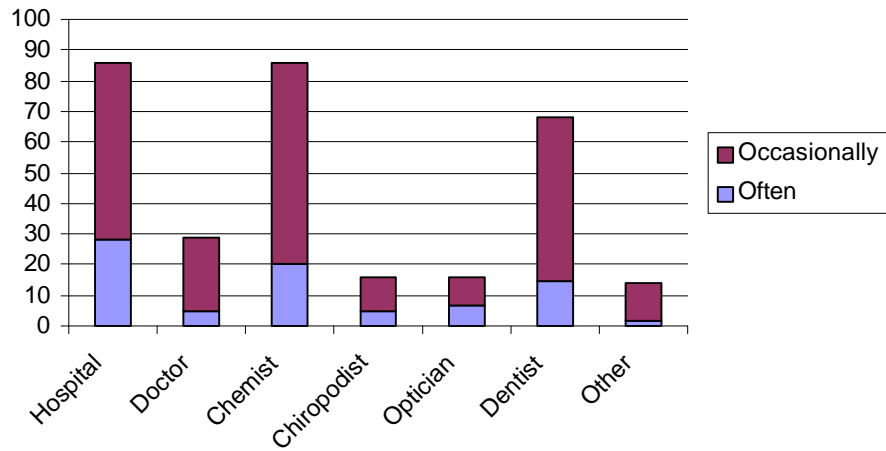
Quality of Medical Services

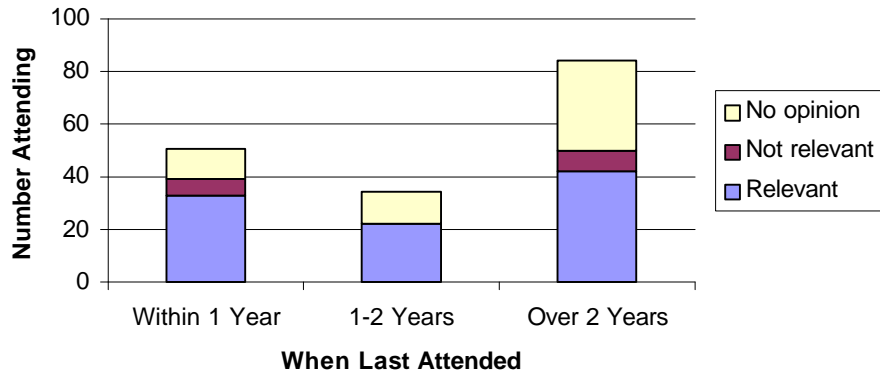
The number of respondents reporting transport difficulties in regard to Medical facilities was;

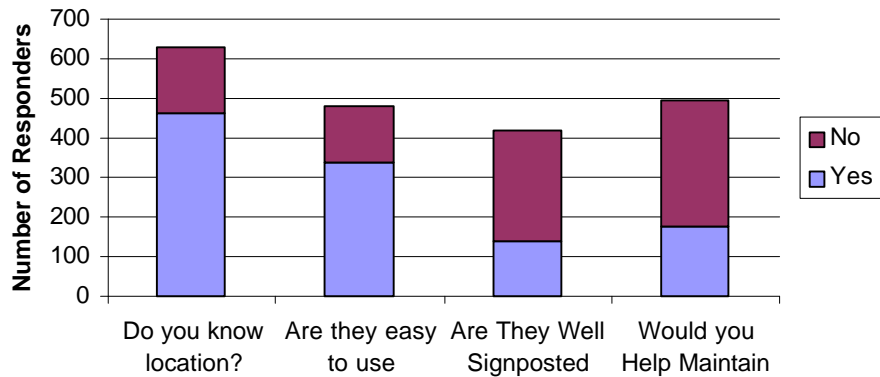

Responders were asked their opinions about Public Footpaths

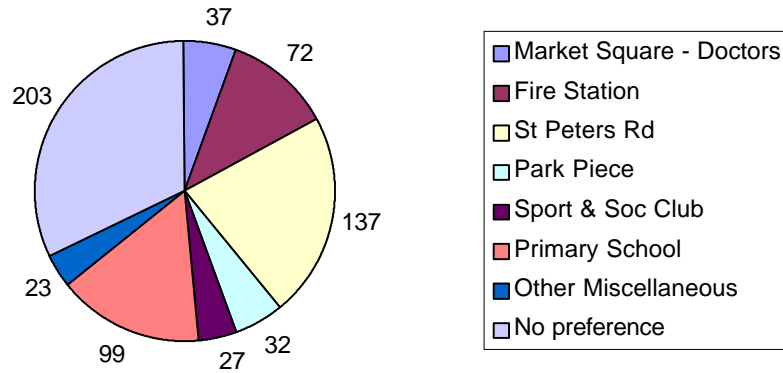

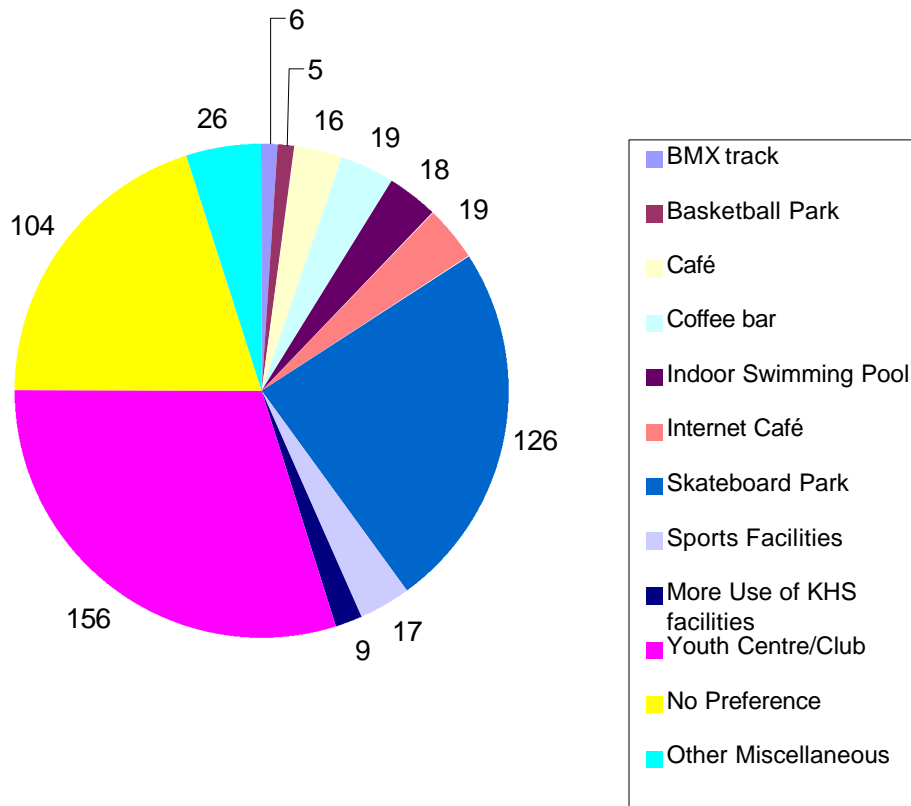
Children’s Playground

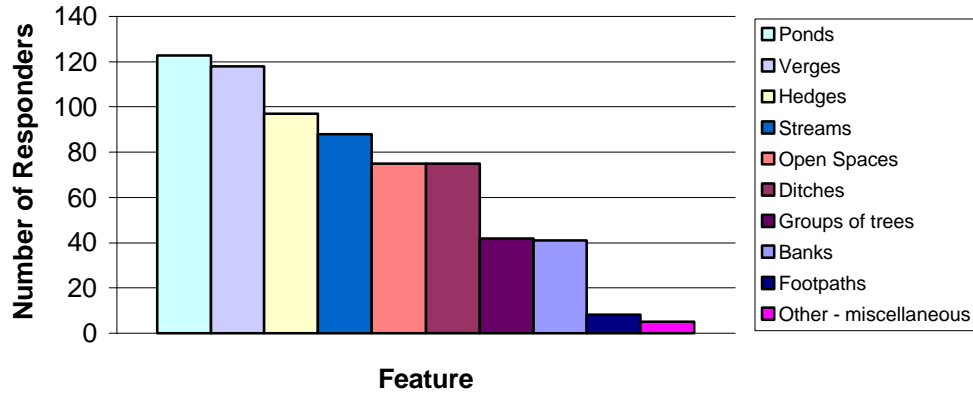
603 of the respondents were in favour of providing facilities for young people. The preferred facilities were:



Landscape Features

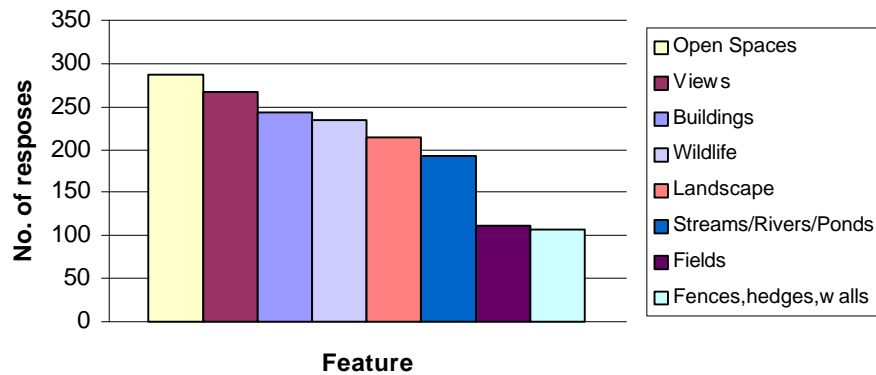
Responders were asked to indicate which Landscape features they felt were neglected – responders could indicate as many features as they wished;

Neglected Landscape Features



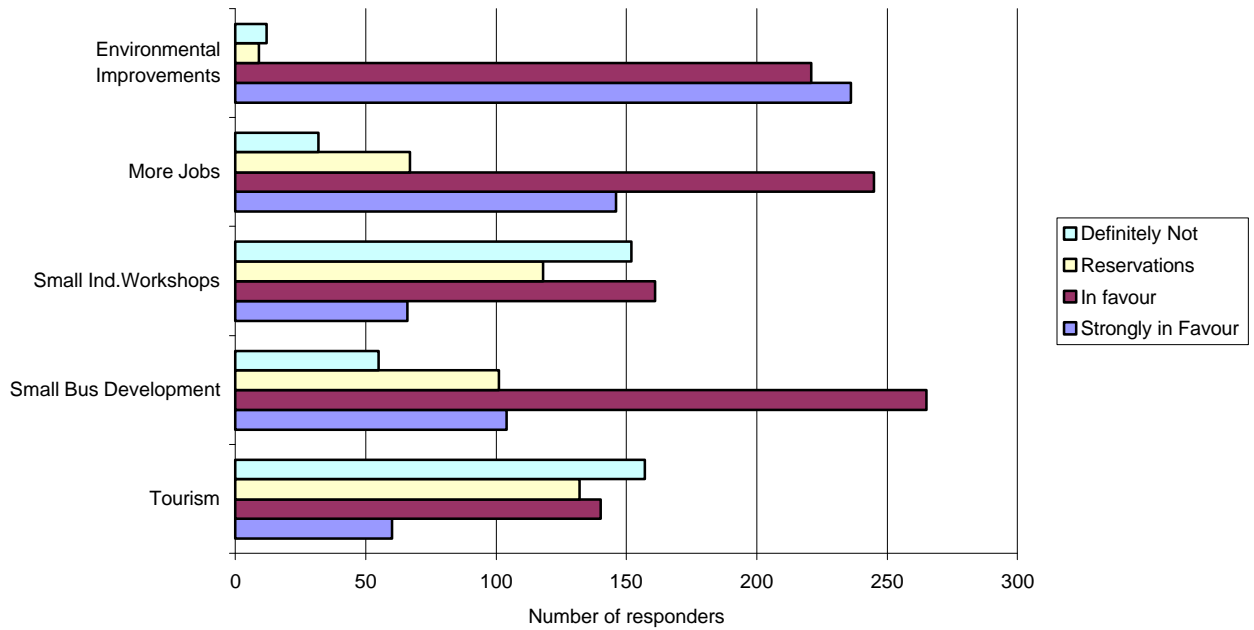

Most Important Features



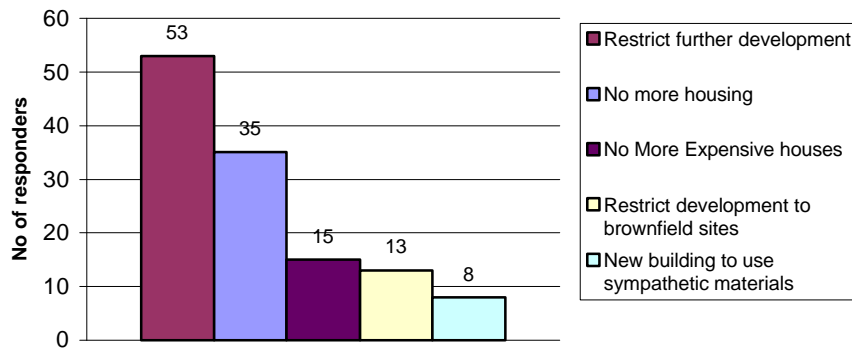

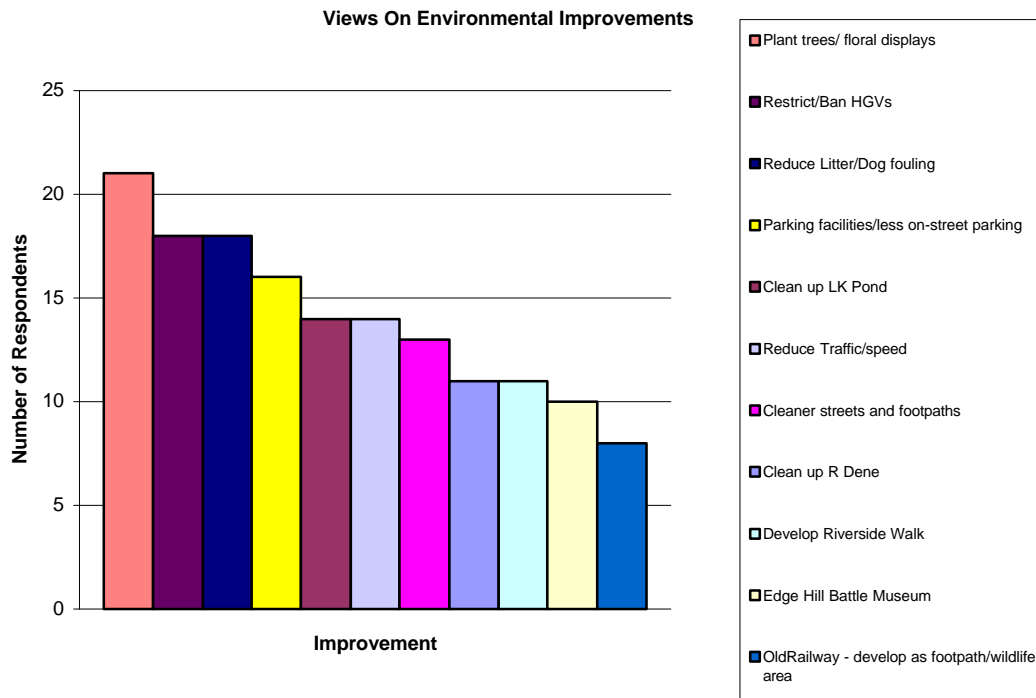

Traffic and Parking

In response to the question on whether a car park was needed **303** said **Yes**, while **282** said **No**. However when it came to suggesting locations, only 104 people suggested a location the top 5 responses being:

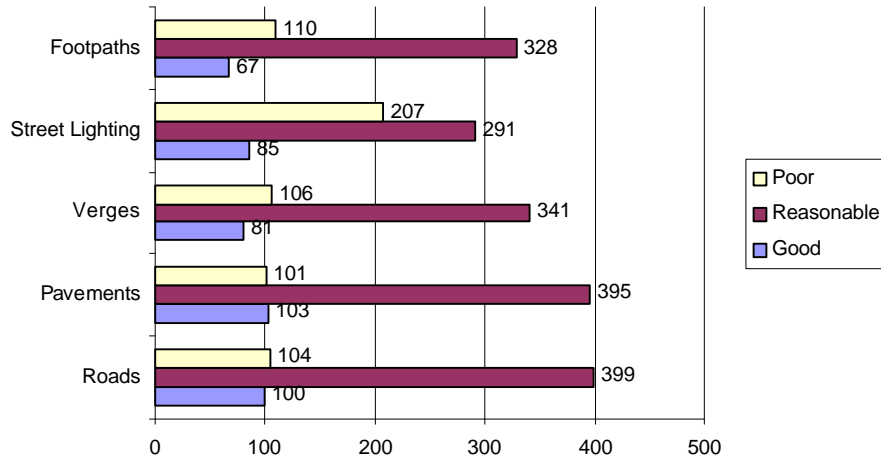

523 people said that they would use recycling facilities, if these were available, amounting to **65%** of responders.

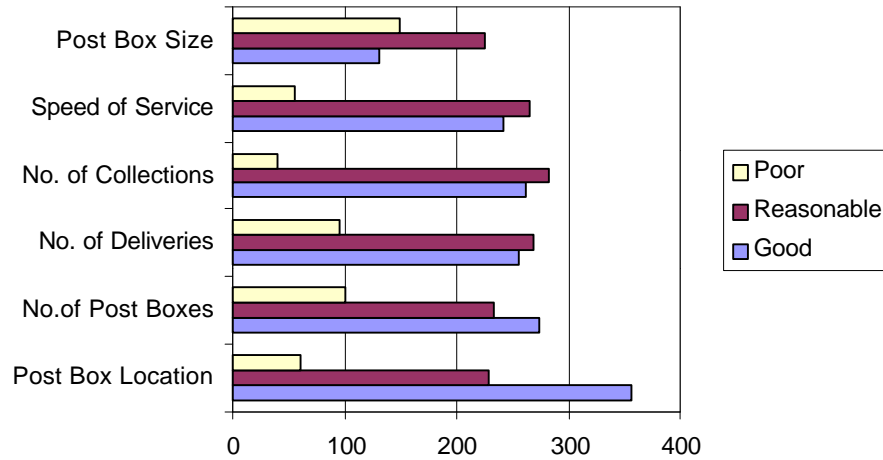

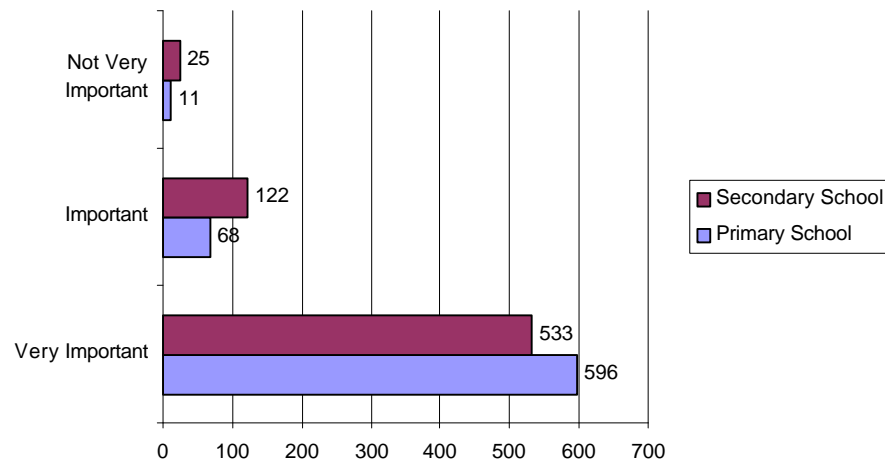
